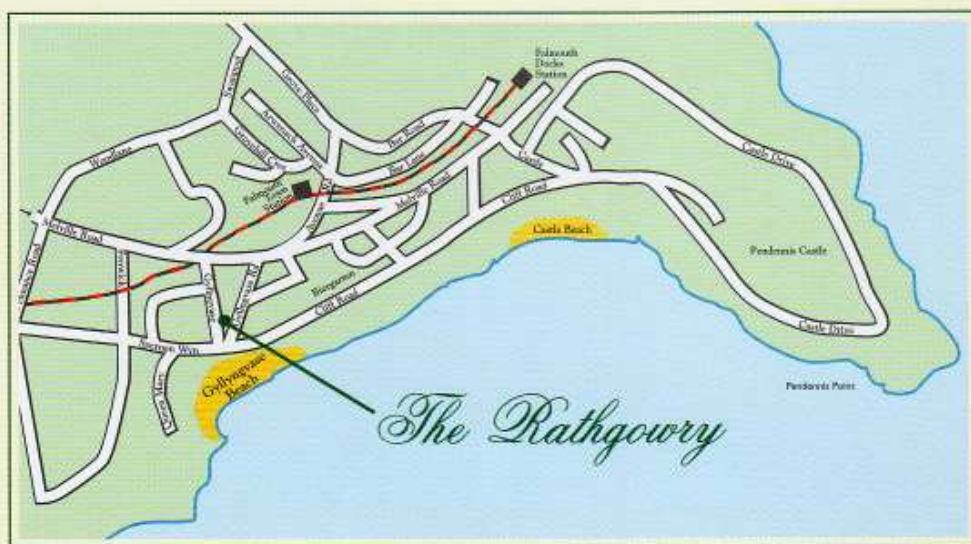
Explore some of the many delightful coastal walks, beautiful gardens or visit the historic Pendennis and St. Mawes Castles.
